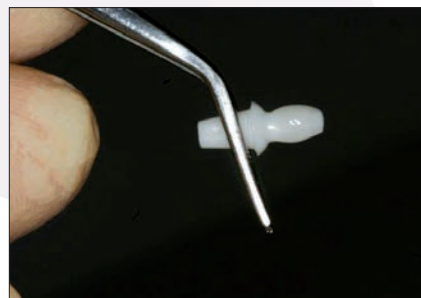

Standard Terms and Conditions of Business creamed GmbH & Co. KG

I. General – Scope of Application

Our Standard Terms and Conditions of Business (referred to below as “STCs”) shall be deemed to be acknowledged by the placing of an order, and in the event that the order is accepted, shall become part of the contract. If the other contracting party does not wish particular STCs to apply it must inform us of this in writing, stating its alterations, in good time – at the latest within two weeks of making an offer. We retain the ownership of and copyright in relation to drawings, sketches and other documents. None of the documents referred to above may be made available to others/third parties without our consent and shall be returned to us without delay upon demand. Differing declarations and agreements require our written confirmation in order to be legally effective.

II. Conclusion of the Contract

1. All offers are subject to change and non-binding. We have no duty to accept orders. We reserve the right to make technical alterations to products and alterations to shape, colour and/or weight within the limits of what is reasonable for the customer.
2. By ordering goods the customer makes a binding declaration that it wishes to purchase the goods ordered. We shall have the right to accept the contractual offer contained within the order within two weeks of its receipt by us. The acceptance can be declared either in writing or by the delivery of the goods to the customer.
3. The contract shall be conditional upon the receipt by us of correct and timely deliveries from our suppliers. The customer shall be informed of any non-availability without delay.
4. We shall not be bound by any mistakes, typing-, calculating- or printing errors. In the event of a costing error we have the right to correct the prices submitted by us.
5. If there are reasons for us to doubt the customer’s ability to meet its financial obligations we may terminate the contract without incurring any liability for damages.
6. The customer is liable for incorrect orders. It shall bear the risk that the goods or equipment which it orders are suitable and permitted for the intended purpose. Recommendations by our company in relation thereto are non-binding.
7. An appropriate charge shall be made as standard for the loan of equipment for hire.

III. Prices

1. All prices are subject to change. Orders shall be carried out at the prices valid on the day of delivery. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, our prices are exclusive of packaging, delivery and insurance.
2. All prices stated are net prices to which the rate of statutory value added tax applicable at the relevant time shall be added. All deliveries shall be made ex works exclusive of delivery and transport costs.
3. Payment is due immediately without deduction.
4. The customer shall pay interest on the debt at a rate of 8% above the base rate during the period in which payment is late. We reserve the right to provide evidence of and claim higher damages for late payment.
5. In the event that the payment of an invoice is late, all other invoiced amounts shall become immediately payable.
6. The price shall already have taken a discount of 3% into account and no further discount shall be allowed under any circumstances.
7. Deliveries abroad shall only be made upon prepayment.
8. In particular cases we reserve the right to effect delivery only upon prepayment or for cash on delivery.
9. The customer shall have a right of set off only if his counterclaims have been recognised by a final judgement which cannot be appealed or are accepted by us.
10. Cheques and bills of exchange shall be deemed to be paid only at the time they are honoured. They shall be accepted as payment subject to the reservation of all rights and the reimbursement of usual bank interest, deductions and charges.
11. We have the right to refuse performance pursuant to § 321 BGB (§ 321 German Civil Code) if the customer’s financial circumstances materially deteriorate before the conclusion of the contract and - despite careful checks - we first become aware of this after the contract is concluded.

IV. Retention of Title

1. Until the fulfilment of all claims (including all current account balance claims) of the seller against the buyer existing now or in the future on the basis of any legal ground whatsoever, the seller shall be granted security. Upon demand the seller shall – at its option - release the security, insofar as its value exceeds the value of the claims by more than 20% over a sustained period.
2. The goods shall remain the property of the seller. Their processing or alteration shall at all times be effected for the seller as manufacturer but without obligation on its part. If the seller’s (co-)ownership is extinguished due to amalgamation with another object, it is now agreed that the buyer’s (co-) ownership of the whole object shall be transferred to the seller in proportion to value (invoice value). The buyer shall safeguard the (co-)ownership of the seller free of charge. Goods in which the seller has (co-) ownership shall be referred to below as “Retained Goods”.
3. The buyer has the right to process and sell the Retained Goods in the proper course of business as long as it is not in default of payment. Pledges and assignments by way of security are not permitted. Claims relating to the Retained Goods arising from resale or other legal ground (insurance, tort) (including all current account balance claims) are now assigned in full to the seller by way of security. The seller irrevocably authorises it to collect the assigned claims for the seller’s account in its own name. This authorisation to collect claims can only be revoked if the buyer does not properly perform its payment obligations.
4. In the event that the Retained Goods are seized by a third party, the buyer shall draw attention to the seller’s proprietary interests and inform the seller without delay.
5. In the event of a breach of contract by the buyer – in particular late payment – the seller shall have the right to take back the Retained Goods or, if applicable, demand that the buyer assigns its claims against third parties for the return of the goods. The taking back or seizure of the Retained Goods by the seller shall not constitute a termination of the contract.

V. Delivery Time

Delivery times shall be met as far as possible but are not binding upon us. If a binding delivery time has been given we shall not accept liability for the inability to fulfil our obligations if delays occur due to unforeseen circumstances e.g. force majeure, disruption to operations, lack of raw materials or delays by our suppliers.

Claims for damages or consequential losses as a result of delayed delivery are excluded in all cases. The commencement and termination of deliveries, installations and other work shall, in principle, take place pursuant to separate written agreement.

VI. Transport, Shipping

1. Deliveries shall in principle be at the risk of the person placing the order.
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3. If the buyer is in default of accepting delivery this shall have the same consequences as if handover has taken place.
4. Deliveries are insured for the account and at the expense of the recipient.
5. All deliveries shall be made ex works excluding shipping and packaging costs and likewise at the expense and risk of the recipient.
6. Alternative arrangements must be agreed in writing in each case.

VII. Guarantee / Liability

1. Defects in part of a delivery cannot result in the rejection of the entire delivery; illustrations, measurements and weight specifications are not binding. Goods manufactured to the customer’s own specifications shall not be taken back under any circumstances. It shall not be possible to cancel an order for a custom-made product after production has commenced under any circumstances. The person placing the order shall assume responsibility for ensuring that the use of the drawings, samples and other similar data submitted does not infringe the rights of third parties.
2. In the event of a legitimate complaint acknowledged by us, the goods can - at our option - be repaired, replaced or reimbursement made for their decrease in value. Complaints must be made within 14 days of receipt of the goods at the latest.
3. Damaged consignments shall only be taken from the forwarder or carrier after the damage has been assessed.
4. Goods which are the subject of a complaint can only be sent back with our agreement. We reserve the right to offset the costs so incurred.
5. We shall be liable for damage caused by defects in the goods delivered by us only if we have been grossly negligent or have acted intentionally.
6. Claims for damages in respect of the breach of a pre-contractual duty (culpa in contrahendo) or the positive violation of a contractual duty and on the basis of tort shall only arise in the event of gross negligence or intention.
7. Exclusions of warranty
Claims for breach of warranty shall not exist if the damage is due to the fact that:
 - the goods were repaired by a third party;
 - the goods were used for a purpose other than that for which they are intended;
 - operating instructions were not observed or the generally accepted, expected rules were disregarded;
 - the purchase price was due but not yet paid;
 - the damage was caused by the user;
 - the complaint is due to an incorrect order or other mistake of the customer.
8. For the products of third parties procured and delivered by us we hereby assign our warranty claims against the manufacturers to our customer. The customer declares that it accepts this assignment.
9. All warranty claims shall expire 12 months after the transfer of risk.
10. In the event of slightly negligent breaches of duty our liability shall be limited to the average direct damages foreseeable for the type of contract in consideration of the nature of the goods. This shall also apply to slightly negligent breaches of duty by our legal representatives or vicarious agents.
11. We shall not be liable to businesses for slightly negligent breaches of non-fundamental contractual duties.

VIII. Copyright

We retain ownership and copyright in respect of drawings, sketches, catalogues, designs and other documents. These may not be made available to others/third parties without our written consent and shall be returned to us upon demand without delay. Differing declarations and agreements require our written confirmation to be legally effective.

IX. Choice of Law, Place of Performance and Jurisdiction

The law of Germany shall apply to our contractual relationship with other contracting parties. The place for performance shall be the place in which our registered office is situated. The Landgericht Marburg (Regional Court in Marburg) shall have jurisdiction over all disputes.

X. Validity of the Contract

If individual provisions should be contrary to the applicable laws of Germany and/or to applicable laws of the European Community, this shall not affect the validity of the other provisions of these STCs. The defective wording shall be replaced by that wording which comes as close as possible to the commercial intention of the invalid provision.

I. General – Scope of Application

Our Standard Terms and Conditions of Business (referred to below as “STCs”) shall be deemed to be acknowledged by the placing of an order, and in the event that the order is accepted, shall become part of the contract. If the other contracting party does not wish particular STCs to apply it must inform us of this in writing, stating its alterations, in good time – at the latest within two weeks of making an offer. We retain the ownership of and copyright in relation to drawings, sketches and other documents. None of the documents referred to above may be made available to others/third parties without our consent and shall be returned to us without delay upon demand. Differing declarations and agreements require our written confirmation in order to be legally effective.

II. Conclusion of the Contract

1. All offers are subject to change and non-binding. We have no duty to accept orders. We reserve the right to make technical alterations to products and alterations to shape, colour and/or weight within the limits of what is reasonable for the customer.
2. By ordering goods the customer makes a binding declaration that it wishes to purchase the goods ordered. We shall have the right to accept the contractual offer contained within the order within two weeks of its receipt by us. The acceptance can be declared either in writing or by the delivery of the goods to the customer.
3. The contract shall be conditional upon the receipt by us of correct and timely deliveries from our suppliers. The customer shall be informed of any non-availability without delay.
4. We shall not be bound by any mistakes, typing-, calculating- or printing errors. In the event of a costing error we have the right to correct the prices submitted by us.
5. If there are reasons for us to doubt the customer’s ability to meet its financial obligations we may terminate the contract without incurring any liability for damages.
6. The customer is liable for incorrect orders. It shall bear the risk that the goods or equipment which it orders are suitable and permitted for the intended purpose. Recommendations by our company in relation thereto are non-binding.
7. An appropriate charge shall be made as standard for the loan of equipment for hire.

III. Prices

1. All prices are subject to change. Orders shall be carried out at the prices valid on the day of delivery. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, our prices are exclusive of packaging, delivery and insurance.
2. All prices stated are net prices to which the rate of statutory value added tax applicable at the relevant time shall be added. All deliveries shall be made ex works exclusive of delivery and transport costs.
3. Payment is due immediately without deduction.
4. The customer shall pay interest on the debt at a rate of 8% above the base rate during the period in which payment is late. We reserve the right to provide evidence of and claim higher damages for late payment.
5. In the event that the payment of an invoice is late, all other invoiced amounts shall become immediately payable.
6. The price shall already have taken a discount of 3% into account and no further discount shall be allowed under any circumstances.
7. Deliveries abroad shall only be made upon prepayment.
8. In particular cases we reserve the right to effect delivery only upon prepayment or for cash on delivery.
9. The customer shall have a right of set off only if his counterclaims have been recognised by a final judgement which cannot be appealed or are accepted by us.
10. Cheques and bills of exchange shall be deemed to be paid only at the time they are honoured. They shall be accepted as payment subject to the reservation of all rights and the reimbursement of usual bank interest, deductions and charges.
11. We have the right to refuse performance pursuant to § 321 BGB (§ 321 German Civil Code) if the customer’s financial circumstances materially deteriorate before the conclusion of the contract and - despite careful checks - we first become aware of this after the contract is concluded.

IV. Retention of Title

1. Until the fulfilment of all claims (including all current account balance claims) of the seller against the buyer existing now or in the future on the basis of any legal ground whatsoever, the seller shall be granted security. Upon demand the seller shall – at its option - release the security, insofar as its value exceeds the value of the claims by more than 20% over a sustained period.
2. The goods shall remain the property of the seller. Their processing or alteration shall at all times be effected for the seller as manufacturer but without obligation on its part. If the seller’s (co-)ownership is extinguished due to amalgamation with another object, it is now agreed that the buyer’s (co-) ownership of the whole object shall be transferred to the seller in proportion to value (invoice value). The buyer shall safeguard the (co-)ownership of the seller free of charge. Goods in which the seller has (co-) ownership shall be referred to below as “Retained Goods”.
3. The buyer has the right to process and sell the Retained Goods in the proper course of business as long as it is not in default of payment. Pledges and assignments by way of security are not permitted. Claims relating to the Retained Goods arising from resale or other legal ground (insurance, tort) (including all current account balance claims) are now assigned in full to the seller by way of security. The seller irrevocably authorises it to collect the assigned claims for the seller’s account in its own name. This authorisation to collect claims can only be revoked if the buyer does not properly perform its payment obligations.
4. In the event that the Retained Goods are seized by a third party, the buyer shall draw attention to the seller’s proprietary interests and inform the seller without delay.
5. In the event of a breach of contract by the buyer – in particular late payment – the seller shall have the right to take back the Retained Goods or, if applicable, demand that the buyer assigns its claims against third parties for the return of the goods. The taking back or seizure of the Retained Goods by the seller shall not constitute a termination of the contract.

V. Delivery Time

Delivery times shall be met as far as possible but are not binding upon us. If a binding delivery time has been given we shall not accept liability for the inability to fulfil our obligations if delays occur due to unforeseen circumstances e.g. force majeure, disruption to operations, lack of raw materials or delays by our suppliers.

Claims for damages or consequential losses as a result of delayed delivery are excluded in all cases. The commencement and termination of deliveries, installations and other work shall, in principle, take place pursuant to separate written agreement.

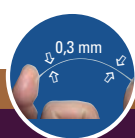
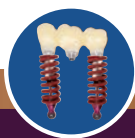
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
